HOI AN

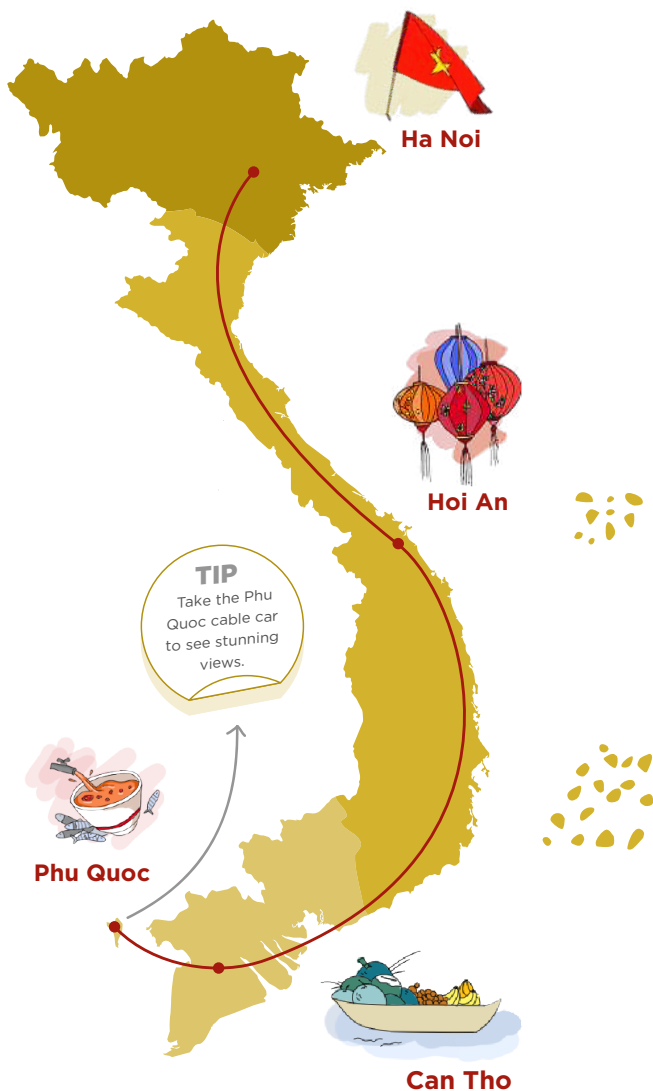
